Said project is for the replacement of 1-1/2" of asphalt concrete along with repairing concrete joints. This project is a 80%/20% split. Project estimate is \$918,559.00 which includes inspection. Project is to be bid May, 2018. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- **2. Resolution #699-17.** Authorize the Allen County Engineer to execute a LPA Federal Project Agreement for countywide guardrail improvements and authorize Brion E.
