10:37 a.m.	2018 Budget Review – Elected Officials and Department Heads (Commissioner Noonan present)			
	Commissioner Noonan presented the preliminary 2018 budget. The budget shows 2017 budget, revised budget through November 2018 as well as the proposed 2018 budget. Budget is slightly higher than 2017. Some of the increases result in storage of public documents at Lane's Storage, a 1-1/2% increase to the salary line (2017 shows 1.5% increase for last pay plus \$200 bonus). Commissioner's office made some adjustments to their salary line as result of change in duties, etc. Auditor's salary line items have changed as a result of assuming benefit responsibilities. Capital Project Manager is now being paid from the Commissioner's budget. 2017 budget was \$27.1 million and 2018 budget is \$27.8 million plus carry-over totaling \$28.4 million. Commissioner Sneary discussed impact of the MCO sales tax to Allen County. The loss to Allen County will be approximately \$1 million. Allen County won't see all of it this year but will see the total effect next year.
