- 2. Resolution #281-18. Allocate and encumber funds to the Village of Spencerville from the Motor Vehicle Permissive Tax Fund. The amount to be allocated and encumbered is \$14,072.56. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #282-18. Establish Sharf Road from Fruend Road north to curves, Spencer Township, Allen County, Ohio. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 4. Resolution #283-18. Appoint Joshua Parker to the Lima-Allen County Regional Transit authority Board of Trustees. Mr. Parker's term shall commence immediately and expire April 14, 2021. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 5. Resolution #284-18. Re-appoint Brion Rhodes to serve on the District 13 Ohio Public Works commission Integrating Committee. Mr. Rhodes term shall commence May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2021. A. County Engineer

1. **Resolution #285-18.** Authorize the Allen County Engineer to execute a Final Legislation Agreement for the Elida Road Project and authorize the Allen County Engineer to serve as the LPA representative for said project. Per Dave Louth, the county applied for and received federal funding to repair a section of Elida Road between the City of Delphos Corporation Limits and Ball Road. There are concrete joints underneath roadway that are separating. This area was repaired back in 2001. ODOT will be overseeing this project. The county's share is \$129.376.00 and the federal funds will cover the remaining portion. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

B. Sanitary Engineer

- 1. Resolution #287-18. Authorize the purchase of one (1) Cues Retro Fit Lamp II Pan and Tilt Lateral Camera. Per Bill Horvath, there is a lateral launch unit on this truck. When in main line doing video work, they are able to launch up through the laterals and inspect county/private owner laterals. This addition will allow better maneuverability to steer and control.
