- 2. Resolution #293-18. Authorize the extension of a lease agreement with the Mental Health and Recovery Services Board for the lease of office space for the Allen County Juvenile Court Community Control Department. This is for SFY'19 July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #294-18. Approve Coroner/Medical Examiner Toxicology Reimbursement Agreement with the Ohio Department of Health. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 4. Resolution #295-18. Establish Perry Chapel Road from Harding Highway (SR 309) to approximately 2,000' south, Perry Township. The right-of-way width shall be 60'. Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

DISCUSSION:

- A. <u>Department of Job & Family Services</u> (No one present)
 - 1. Resolution #296-18. Approve an Independent Contractor Agreement with Twin Elm Studio, LLC for website and logo design services. This is an

amount not to exceed \$7,999.00. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

B. Sanitary Engineer

- 1. Resolution #297-18. Resolution approving General Plan, Declaring the Necessity to Construct and establishing method of repayment for the North Cable Road Sewer Improvement Area Project, American Township. Per Bill Horvath, stated there are two (2) projects that will be serviced. This is an assessment project. Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 2. Resolution #298-18. Accept proposal from Shaferly Excavating, Ltd. for the construction of the North Cable Road Low Pressure Sanitary Sewer Collection System, American Township. Per Bill Horvath, this is to low pressure system, force main and abandon their septics and connect their gravity to the station. This contract is in the amount of \$28,817.00. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #299-18. Accept bid and enter into contract with Shaferly Excavating, Ltd. for the Yoder Road Sewer Improvement Area Project, Perry Township. Per Bill Horvath, this project is for approximately 1200' of force main that will service five (5) property owners. One (1) bid was received in the amount of \$67,717.50. This will also be an assessment project. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 4. Resolution #300-18. Authorize the purchase of one (1) Horizon SQ3TS Portable Traffic Signals System through A & A Safety, as per the Ohio STS Purchase Program. Per Bill Horvath, this is for the work zone areas, mainly busy roadways. Cost of purchase is \$54,000.00. Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

Douglass Degen, Drainage Engineer, when Greater Ohio Ethanol decided to build in Allen County, there was a meandering stream - Lost Creek - on the property. Greater Ohio Ethanol agreed with Ohio EPA and the Army Corp of Engineers to do some stream mitigation. There was additional stream mitigation that was required. Greg Krueger, a partner of Greater Ohio Ethanol and also farmed on Swaney Road, entered into an agreement with Army Corp of Engineer's, Ohio EPA and the business partners of Greater Ohio Ethanol. A mitigation project was coordinated east of Swanev Road to an upstream tributary of Sugar Creek. As things progressed, the business partnership fell apart with Greater Ohio Ethanol. A few months ago, the Board approved as a single county petitioned project with Lost Creek, an easement of this nature. There is a petition ditch that is on county maintenance, which is now part of the Sugar Creek/Warrington Project #1334. A couple weeks ago, the Army Corp of Engineer's and Ohio EPA, has reviewed the proposed Conservation Easement - Sugar Creek. All are in agreement. Nathan Davis explained the type of maintenance that will be performed on said project.
