The purchase price is in the amount of \$14,500.00. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 2. Resolution #341-18. Enter into an agreement with Materials Testing, Inc. for the Allen County Juvenile Detention Center Project for construction materials testing and inspection. The cost to perform this testing is an amount not to exceed \$55,000.00. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #342-18. Approve Change Order #1 with Peterson Construction Company for the Allen County Juvenile Detention Center Project. This change order is for the acoustic ducking in the gym at an additional cost of \$2,379.00.

- **2. Resolution #346-18.** Resolution to approve a Master Lease Agreement with the Allen County Educational Services Center.
- 3. Resolution #347-18. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding with the Allen County Board of DD. Per Theresa Schnipke, this is a collaboration agreement. The Allen County Educational Services Center has requested that Board of DD house the entire pre-school program. The MOU through Resolution #347-18 addresses the role each entity plays for the housing of the pre-school program. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolutions were approved unanimously.

1. Resolution #348-18. Authorize submission of a grant application to the Ohio Department of Youth Services for FY'2019.
