- 1. Resolution #456-18. Confirm submission of the 2019 Tax Budget. Rachael Gilroy stated the county is on track with what was estimated for 2018. There is a slight increase in interest income and sales tax. Expenses are increased for next year. Estimates for expenses exceed estimates for the revenue so will need to be careful next year. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 2. Resolution #457-18. Enter into an Early Intervention Service Coordination Grant Agreement with the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- **3. Resolution #458-18**. Declare a 2003 Cub Cadet Fire UTV and a 2003 John Deere EMS Gator UTV at the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management unsuitable for county use and authorize sale of same by internet auction.

Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

- 4. Resolution #462-18. Resolution authorizing the issuance of \$5,000,000.00 Juvenile Detention Center Bonds. Per Rachael Gilroy, closing is set for next week. Working with Treasurer's office and bond counsel to get this finalized. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 5. Resolution #463-18. Approve Change Order #2 with Peterson Construction Company for the Allen County Juvenile Detention Center Project. This is an increase of \$77,899.00. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

- 1. Resolution #459-18. Accept bid and enter into contract with The Shelly Company for the County and Township Roads Resufacing-18 Program. Per Dave Louth, two (2) bids were received with the low bid being the Shelly Company in the amount of \$1,117,914.56. The engineer's estimate for the project was \$1,139,000.00 Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 2. Resolution #460-18. Approve the engineer's estimate of material and labor necessary for the replacement of the bridge deck on the Gomer Road Bridge, Sugar Creek Township. Per Brion Rhodes, this is a truss bridge built in 1951. Looking at replacing the deck with a wood deck. The engineer's estimate is \$86,169.51.

 Commissioner Noonan moved for approval.

 Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #461-18. Enter into an agreement for professional services with Richland Engineering Limited for the inspection of the Metcalf Street Bridge, Lima, Ohio. Per Brion Rhodes, this bridge

	is the largest structure in Allen County – 380' in main span. There will be a temporary closure during inspection. Cost to perform the inspection is an amount not to exceed \$15,200.00. City of Lima will be 50% of cost. This bridge was built in 1923. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
