Allen Soil and Water Conservation District 1. **Resolution #713-18.** Resolution for permission to remove concrete dam structure. **Beth Seibert** provided an overview of the concrete dam structure. This structure is located in the Ottawa River, just north of SR 81 in Allentown. The eighty five year old dam is not being used for the purpose that it was created and is a barrier to fish passage and water quality. The removal is planned for late summer of 2019. The dam is 88 feet long, four feet tall and two and half feet thick. A 33 foot section near the middle of the dam is worn down considerably - with time having eroded the dam down as much as 11 inches in height in that section. There are two (2) public meetings scheduled as it relates to the removal of this dam structure. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary.
