	Nathan Davis, Assistant Drainage Engineer, discussed funded petition project. Discussed County Engineer funding, which was not figured in assessments received. Provided an overview of the project and read into record the Report of the County Engineer. Discussed assessment calculation process and recommended assessments be collected over a period of five (5) years. Mr. Davis read into record Mr. Gaskill's letter.
	The Commissioners heard from those landowners for or against the project. Brad Core, Amanda Township Trustee, stated that the Township Trustees filed the petition and the scope of the project is what the trustees filed based on conversations with various landowners in the watershed as it relates to water problems. Core stated that the portion that is bad is on the Port Authority property. The Trustees perspective as to the water issue is that the tile is old.

Commissioner Begg moved to proceed with the construction of the project – Resolution #726-18 and recommended that assessments be collected for a period of five (5) years.
