- 2. Resolution #109-19. Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor. This approval/certification is retroactive to October, 2018. Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #110-19. Enter into contract with Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. for various county buildings. This contract covers eight (8) county building. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

- 4. Resolution #111-19. Enter into a service agreement with Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. for pigeon control at the Savings Building.
