- 1. Notice to Legislative Authority Ohio Division of Liquor Control Hawthorne Hills Event Center D1, D2 and D3 permit Request/Do Not Request Hearing. Commissioner Sneary moved to not request a hearing. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and approved unanimously.
- 2. Resolution #253-17. Enter into an agreement with Scott Miller for the lease of county property for agricultural purposes. The lease agreement is for seventeen (17) farmable acres for a period beginning January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #259-17. Authorizes the re-filing of a Type 2 Non-withdrawal Annexation Petition of 1.759 acres, more or less, of real property in Spencer Township to the Village of Spencerville. Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

DISCUSSION:

A. Family and Children First Council

1. Resolution #295-16A. Amend Resolution #295-16, approve Allen County Healthier Buckeye Council Community Navigation Subgrant Agreements with various agencies. Amber Martin stated that the House and Senate have both passed to extend the grant to December 31, 2017. Currently working with all sub-grantees to extend the grant deadline as well. Looking to add one (1) additional navigator for Children Services Board and one (1) part-time navigator for the Child Support Enforcement Agency. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and

the resolution was approved unanimously.

B. County Engineer

- 1. Resolution #254-17. Accept proposal and enter into contract with U.S. Bridge, a Division of The Ohio Bridge Corporation, for the supply of material for the Slabtown Road Bridge. Ron Meyer stated that two (2) bids were received with one of the bids being non-responsive. Said contract is in the amount of \$74,556.00. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 2. Resolution #255-17. Approve the Engineer's estimate of material and labor necessary for the replacement of the bridge deck on the Slabtown Road Bridge. Per Ron Meyer, the estimate for materials and labor is in the amount of \$44,087.93. The bridge was built in 1963, with the load limit placed in 2013. Commissioner Begg moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sneary. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 3. Resolution #256-17. Approve the 2017 County and Township Road Program and authorize the County Engineer to proceed by Force Account. Per Dave Louth, the total amount of the 2017 County and Township Road Program is \$1,932,994.00. Commissioner Sneary moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 4. Resolution #257-17. Authorize the Clerk of Board to post notice and advertise to receive bids for the Liquid Asphalt for Tar and Chip Work for the 2017 County Engineer's Road Program. Dave Louth stated they are proposing 437,692 gallons of liquid asphalt at an estimated total cost of \$745,076.00. The bid opening date is May 5, 2017. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Begg. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
