Clocktower Dedication/Reception

Commissioner Begg stated the Clocktower has been repaired for about a year. The first donation was made almost three (3) years ago. When Commissioner Noonan and Commissioner Begg took office, they noticed the buildings needed repairs. After a building assessment was conducted, it was decided the first thing to repair was the roof on the Courthouse. It was also determined that the Clocktower was also causing some of the roofing issues. The Commissioners had two (2) options: 1) remove the Clocktower or 2) repair the Clocktower. Dana Sterling had been in contact with a gentleman by a man named Phil Wright. He is with the Tower Clock Company. Mr. Wright stated he could put a restored couric-specific 1884 clock at a cost of \$90,000-\$95,000. Todd Sutton with Potash, then Nutrien, came forward with a donation. Sam Bassitt and Dan Reiff came forward and offered to help raise money. Thanks to everyone's efforts, the county was able to raise enough money to repair the

	Clocktower. Ann Decker provided a short video of the Clocktower restoration. Commissioner Begg thanked Michael Ayers for providing the frames for prints donated by David Adams. The linoleum-block relief print of the Allen County Courthouse was created by David Adams at the centennial of the Courthouse, 1982. Only 50 prints were made from the block. Commissioner Begg presented the picture/frame to various donors.
