Roadway Improvement - The following legal notice is to receive bids for the improvement of the shoulders and the widening the pavement to 24 feet, centered on the existing center of pavement, along Buckeye Road and sections of Dixie Hwy. and McClain Road in Shawnee Township, Allen County, Ohio. The project includes reconstructing the edge of pavement to create two 12' lanes, building a new shoulder and blending to existing roadside ditch. The entire roadway will then be milled and paved with an average thickness of 1.5" of 448 polymerized asphalt concrete, type 1H, PG-70-22M, to match the new width of the entire roadway. Approximately 400 feet of new approaches will also be constructed at the CSX Railroad crossing. This will include full depth reconstruction 200 feet both east and west of the crossing including work within the CSX Railroad right-of-way. Coordination with CSX inspectors and flaggers will be required. 448 Asphalt Concrete shall have a bitumen content of 6.2% and may contain a maximum of 10% recycled material. Aggregate to be used in hot mix shall be stockpiled, for sampling by county and testing at least two weeks before being used in hot mix. Stone stockpiles not passing Allen County Engineer's specifications as result of testing, shall be rejected for use in this contract. The total project length is approximately 9,787 feet all of which make up the Buckeye Road Improvement Project. Included is 605 linear feet of curb and gutter, 1000 feet of linear grading, catch basin removal/relocation, storm sewer installation and pavement markings.

Traffic Signal Improvement - Also included in this project is the replacement of three separate traffic signals at three separate locations:

- 1) Buckeye Road @ Dixie Hwy – Complete traffic signal replacement. This includes cabinet, controller, poles w/mast arms, signal heads, video detection system, power cables, signal cables, **conduit bored under pavement** as well as all necessary connections and testing.
- 2) Buckeye Road @ J.S.M.C. (General Dynamics) - Partial traffic signal replacement. This includes cabinet, controller, signal heads, video detection system, power cables, signal cables as well as all necessary connections and testing. Poles, mast arms and existing conduit will remain in place at this location.
- 3) Ft. Amanda Road @ Adgate Road - Complete traffic signal replacement. This includes cabinet, controller, poles w/mast arms, signal heads, video detection system, power cables, signal cables as well as all necessary connections and testing. **The conduit has already been bored under pavement at this location.**

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Allen County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

Bidders will be charged a fee of **\$30.00** to submit a bid electronically. For this project, bids will **ONLY** be received and accepted via the online electronic bid service through QuestCDN.com.

Electronic Bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Allen County Commissioners and will be **opened online** by the clerk of said County, on **Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at 11:00 a.m.**

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a 10% Bid Guarantee and Contract Bond in accordance with Sections 153.54 and 153.571 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must provide evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than **September 24, 2021**. To allow proper time for the paperwork to be processed, the contractor will not commence work before June 1, 2021.

No bidder shall be permitted to withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the time of bid opening.

The Board of Allen County Commissioners, Allen County, Ohio reserves the right to reject any or all bids submitted or to waive any irregularities pursuant to Section 9.31 of the Revised Code.
