NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING # 2 Program Year 2021 Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program

The Allen County Commissioners (Allen County), in partnership with Putnam County and the City of Delphos intend to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) for funding under the Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program (CHIP), which includes funds from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investments Partnership (HOME) programs administered by the State of Ohio and funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and Ohio Housing Trust Funds (OHTF). The partnership together is eligible to apply for \$1,100,000 in Program Year 2021 for affordable housing activities.

Allen County as the Grantee of the Partnership will request funds for the following activities: **HOME funds**: Private Owner Rehabilitation \$484,000/11 units (in conjunction with CDBG); New Construction with Habitat for Humanity \$30,000/1 units; Tenant Based Rental Assistance \$10,000/5 units; Administration \$52,400. **CDBG funds**: Private Owner Rehabilitation \$114,000/11 units (in conjunction with HOME); Owner Home Repair \$290,000/19 units (in conjunction with OHTF), Administration & Fair Housing \$79,600; **OHTF Funds**: Owner Home Repair \$40,000/19 units (in conjunction with CDBG). The partners will also commit program income funds for related activities.

On April 8, 2021, Allen County held the first of two public hearings to inform citizens about the CDBG program, including an explanation of eligible activities and requirements.

A second public hearing will be held on June 17, 2021 at 11:30 a.m. in the Allen County Commissioners office.
