The stone will be purchased and stockpiled by each township prior to construction. The contractor will be responsible for loading the stone onto trucks and hauling to the various jobsites on the project. Unit price for stone shall reflect loading, hauling and installation cost only.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Allen County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must provide evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than <u>September 15, 2023</u>.

No bidder shall be permitted to withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the time of bid opening.
