- Discussion on damaged door and sprinklers at the Justice Center -after reviewing cameras, Jason Patchet believes a cable snapped in the door and therefore the door
 - cable snapped in the door and therefore the door hit the sprinklers and the door and rollers were damaged

- -will be replacing the door with a Teledoor at a cost of \$18,800.00
- -door will be installed the week of May 6th
- -the contract will be placed on agenda next week
- Currently working with T&D Interiors on quotes for work to be completed at the Civic Center
- Discussion on the painting of the Court of Appeals Building

- Discussion on a potential fourth option for the roof at the Court of Appeals Building -lay z-gerts on existing roof and then lay additional metal and gutters
- Discussion on the job being completed in-house, but Jason Patchet does not feel comfortable with doing so
 - -Commissioners ask Jason Patchet to ask Chris Widener, WDC Group, if he would have any contacts for Jason Patchet to reach out to for painting the roof
- Discussion on new staff members joining the team and reorganization of the department
- General discussion and review of proposed camera placement and access control of the Administration Building
 - -discussion on revisions to the proposed placement of cameras and access control
 - -38 cameras and 50 doors proposed
 - -discussion on panic buttons—currently they are not in the security and data plans
