ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Online bids for the construction of the Gomer Sewer Project will be received by The Board of Allen County Commissioners using the Quest Construction Data Network. Only electronic bids will be accepted through [www.questcdn.com](http://www.questcdn.com) until 10:30 am local time on November 19, 2021, for all labor and furnishing of materials and equipment necessary to complete the Project known as the GOMER SEWER PROJECT, at which time the bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of constructing approximately 22,900 l.f. of 6" force main HDPE directional bored, 312 l.f. of 12" casing HDPE directional bored, 15,143 l.f. 1.5" lateral installed by HDD, 4,634 l.f. 2" HDPE installed by HDD, 6,153 l.f. 3" HDPE installed by HDD, 2,807 l.f. 4" HDPE installed by HDD, 9 each flush stations, 8 each air releases, 1 pump station, 146 each grinder pump packages, 146 each precast ballasts, 1 odor control equipment and all related work as shown on the Construction Drawings and called for in the Specifications. The Engineer's Estimate for this Project is \$3,147,381.00. Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, as indicated in the Bid Form.

A contractor may view the contract documents at no cost prior to deciding to becoming a planholder. A pre-bid conference will be held on November 9, 2021, 10:00 a.m. local time at the office of the Allen County Sanitary Engineer located at 3230 North Cole Street, Lima, Ohio 45801. Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A-Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term "iron and steel products" means the following products made primarily of iron or steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials. The de minimis and minor components waiver (as applicable) to this contract.
