- 5. Resolution #829-24. Accept proposal and enter into contract with Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc. for the closure in place sampling and reporting of an underground storage tank at the Allen County Justice Center. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Seibert. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 6. Resolution #830-24. Approve the Allen County Wellness Incentive Policy. Commissioner Seibert moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 7. Resolution #831-24. Resolution to approve Addendum No. 2 for Right of Entry granting Allen County access to enter property located at 201 E. North Street, Lima, OH for the purpose of conducting necessary due diligence required in order to determine the viability of the property for the potential purchase. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Seibert. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

DISCUSSION

A. Revolving Loan Fund

1.Resolution #832-24. Authorize a Satisfaction and Cancellation of Mortgage for Keyburg Properties, LLC. through the Allen County Revolving Loan Fund. Commissioner Seibert moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The Revolving Loan was granted in 2009 and the loan has been satisfied as of August of 2024. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

B. Department of Job and Family Services

1.Resolution #602-23C. Amend Resolution #602-23, approve a Subrecipient Agreement between the Allen County Department of Job and Family Services and the Allen County Children Services Board. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Seibert. This is an increase of \$21,079.06 in Title XX Funds. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

2.Resolution #603-23C. Amend Resolution #603-23, approve a Memorandum of Understanding between the Allen County Department of Job and Family Services and the Allen County Children Services Board. Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Seibert. These are the funds returned back to Department of Job and Family Services in an amount of \$10,548.53. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

C.County Engineer

- 1.Resolution #833-24. Accept proposal and enter into contract with The Shelly Company for milling work on South Dixie Highway. Commissioner Seibert moved for approval. Motion seconded by Commissioner Noonan. The Shelly Company will grind out old deteriorated asphalt at a cost not to exceed \$6,175.00. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.
- 2.Resolution #834-24. Authorize the Allen County Engineer to execute an LPA Federal Local-LET Project Agreement for the ALL-Pavement Condition Index and authorizes Brion E. Rhodes, Allen County Engineer, to serve as the LPA representative for said project on behalf of the Board of Allen County Commissioners.

 Commissioner Noonan moved for approval. Motion

seconded by Commissioner Seibert. This is for the West side Township Roads, which will be 100% funded through Federal Funds at a cost of \$24,700.00. The roll was called and the resolution was approved unanimously.

- Discussion on 201 E. North Street -will be moving forward with soil sampling
- Justice Center dock concrete work has been completed
 - -entrance ramp will be completed once the underground storage tank remediation is complete, which is schedule for next Tuesday
- Jack replacement for Civic Center elevator is scheduled to be delivered on November 5th and should be installed the following week
- Commissioner Noonan provided an overview of meeting with the Civic Center yesterday discussing the agreement regarding the working relationship with the amphitheater -discussion on utilizing the scissor lift for installation and removal of lighting
- Provided an overview of bidder interviews for Administration Building Project
 -will have further discussion tomorrow while Chris Widener, WDC Group, is here reviewing bids received
 - -discussion on utilizing a Single Prime Contractor or Multiple Prime Contractors
